Member obligations also including meeting requirements of the Ontario Regulation O. Reg. 288/07: *Source Protection Committees* under the Ontario *Clean Water Act, 2006*, S.O. 2006, c. 22. The legislation and regulations are available at www.ontario.ca.

Member obligations include:

- A three to five year commitment to participate.
- Attend meetings – sometimes as often as once a month (but at this phase of source protection planning implementation it is anticipated that meetings will only be between two and four annually).

The Source Protection Committee (SPC) is responsible to guide the development of updated and amended assessment reports and source protection plans as well as guiding implementation of existing plans. The SPC works in cooperation with the source protection authorities. The SPC considers public input, technical studies, ensures input from local municipalities, and provides advice on source protection plan requirements.
